CSD celebrates the many contributions of Faculty Director Leila Patel, Professor at the University of Johannesburg and the Founding Director of the Centre for Social Development in Africa (CSDA), as she steps down from her role as the South African Research Chair in Welfare and Social Development. A pivotal figure in the development of South Africa's postapartheid social-welfare policy, Dr. Patel is a prolific author and noted expert in social development. She remains engaged in the work of CSDA.

CSD Faculty Associate Stephanie Boddie has garnered tenure at Baylor University, where she holds appointments in the Diane R. Garland School of Social Work and the George W. Truett Theological Seminary.
