<u>Gena Gunn McClendon</u>, director of community engagement and co-director of the Financial Capability and Asset Building initiative, passed away on October 21, 2023. She leaves behind an enduring legacy as a fierce advocate for equity, a champion for the disempowered and a passionate defender of voting rights. <u>More</u>.

<u>Postdoctoral Fellow Aytakin Huseynli</u> will receive the 2024 Society for Social Work and Research Outstanding Social Work Doctoral Dissertation Honorable Mention Award for "Effect of Resource Curse on Child Well-being in Resource-rich States, Specifically in Post-Soviet States." The award will be presented at the society's annual meeting on January 13.

<u>Huseynli</u> presented "The Role of Financial Capability and Asset-Building in Preventing and Reducing Domestic Violence," an invited address, at the International Conference on Prevention of Domestic Violence: Possibilities and Perspectives on December 7 in Baku, Azerbaijan.

<u>Huseynli</u> also led a seminar entitled "Establishment Social Work as a Profession in the Case of Azerbaijan" at Baku Business University on November 17.

Faculty Associate Yingying Zeng, assistant professor in the School of Social Work at the University of Georgia, received the 2023 Disability Manuscript Award Honorary Mention for <u>"A Scoping Review of Needs and</u> Barriers to Achieving A Livable Life among Refugees with Disabilities: Implications for Future Research, Practice, and Policy," which was published in the Journal of Evidence-Based Social Work. Dr. Zeng and the study's coauthors received the award from the Council on Social Work Education at the council's annual program meeting on October 29.

Director Michael Sherraden, International Director Li Zou, and Faculty Directors Jin Huang and Suo Deng presented "Child Development Accounts: Social Innovation for Global Impact" during the Social Innovation session of the McDonnell International Scholars Academy's 2023 Global Research Symposium on October 6. While in Baku, <u>Michael Sherraden</u>, <u>Jin Huang</u>, <u>Aytakin Huseynli</u>, <u>Li Zou</u>, and <u>Lissa Johnson</u> met with representatives from the Azerbaijan Ministry of Labor and Social Protection, the Azerbaijan State Committee on Women, Family and Children Issues, and the Azerbaijan Red Crescent Society, as well as with members of the parliaments of Azerbaijan and Kazakhstan. They discussed CSD research on financial capability and asset building, particularly proposals for Child Development Account policy and social work education.

In Uganda, the National Council for Higher Education approved Uganda Christian University's request to require a course on financial capability and asset building (FCAB) for every master's-level social work student. The FCAB Africa team, led by **Faculty Directors David Ansong**, <u>Isaac</u> <u>Koomson</u> and <u>Moses Okumu</u>, is working with the university to develop content for the course.
